This is to verify our understanding that serving as a regional officer of Phi Theta Kappa requires a commitment from the local chapter and the college administration. It is understood that only chapters in good standing with both the International and the Texas Phi Theta Kappa offices are eligible to run for regional office. Thus, it is understood that:

1. Our chapter has submitted the last required annual chapter report to Phi Theta Kappa Headquarters.
2. Our chapter's regional dues are current.
3. Regional officers receive a registration scholarship to the International Honors Institute.
4. Regional officers will receive a registration scholarship to Regional Institute. The Texas Region will pay all Regional Coordinator approved travel and lodging expenses.
5. Payment of Regional expenses
  - A. Expenses approved by the Regional Coordinator and incurred in attending regional planning meetings will be paid by the Texas Region.
  - B. The Texas Region will waive the registration fees for regional officers to attend regional meetings.
  - C. The individual representing the chapter as the regional officer will receive a \$1000 scholarship to help with expenses.
6. The local chapter will be responsible for the regional officer's transportation to regional meetings.
7. The college is committed to helping the student fulfill his or her obligations as a regional officer. This includes allowing the student to make up academic work missed while attending regional functions.
